WARD COUNTY BUILDING PERMIT REQUIREMENTS / GUIDELINES

Requirements for Building permits:

- 1. 1 set of plans to scale. Plans must list total square footage, including foundation. They must also list square footage for decks, porches and entry ways. Plans must also show exterior elevations, including all sides of building and all openings in walls such as doors and windows. A wall section will also need to be completed.
- 2. Plot plan containing the legal description, 911 site address and name of the builder and license number. The plot plan must also show the proposed building footprint including distances to property lines, lot dimensions.
- 3. Unit approval for Sewer, contact the First District Health Unit at 701-852-1376, (801 11th Ave SW).
- 4. The building permit application does not include plumbing & electrical.
- 5. Copy of surveyors stamped certification of soil evaluation (floodplain)
- 6. All living areas of any building in the floodplain must be 1 foot about the flood elevation
- 7. Any variances and special use permit applications approval will be required from the Ward County Planning & Zoning Commission which conducts public hearing meetings on the **third Thursday of every month**. All applications and documents can be located on the Ward County website (http://www.co.ward.nd.us/).

The fees for a building & alteration permits are \$4.50 per \$1,000 per the estimated construction costs.

Appointments for building inspections are setup through this office.

It is the permit holder's responsibility to call for an inspection, for **footings**, **cement walls**, **framing and completion**.

Call 24 hours in advance to schedule an appointment for an inspection.
