Workshop Descriptions
Writing Workshop (Fiction & Poetry) -- If you're the kind of kid who just can't stop telling stories, likes to play with words or dream up your own worlds, then this workshop is for you. You'll write fiction stories or scripts, creating vivid characters who find their way into and out of a variety of situations, and poems to share your perceptions of the world around you. You will write to your heart's content, talk and listen to other writers about ways to make your work stronger, and then share your final copies. Whether you prefer mysteries, fantasy, rhymed poetry, adventure, science fiction or animal tales, come write with us! The writing workshop can accept up to 12 writers.





Visual Arts Workshop -- If you can't stop doodling and you're ready to have fun with different forms of art, then attend the visual arts workshop. 5th graders in Visual Arts I will be introduced to drawing skills, clay sculpture, pastels and acrylics. 6th graders in Visual Arts II will work with clay, pastels, acrylics and color pencils, along with more charcoal practice and drawing with a grid. An Advanced workshop is available for young artists in grades 7 and above. Each artist in the Advanced workshop will choose two art media as a focus, and will study color concepts and matting and framing techniques. The visual arts workshops will be divided by ages and can accept up to 10 artists apiece.

Readers Theatre Workshop -- If you crave the stage and spotlight, then join Readers Theatre this summer. Readers Theatre is a form of drama that uses scripts and vocal expression to tell a story, with limited costumes and props. No memorizing or stage movement is necessary; you just need the ability to read aloud and the DESIRE to perform. Members of the Readers Theatre workshop will rehearse several selections and present these in four public appearances. The Readers Theatre workshop can accept from 10 to 12 readers, and THOSE READERS MUST BE AVAILABLE FOR THE PERFORMANCES!

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Workshops will begin May 21st and 22nd and continue through June, with public performances on June 27th. Participation during the final week of the workshops is ESSENTIAL, especially for Readers Theatre artists. PLEASE CONSIDER THESE DATES CAREFULLY.

Public performances will include an art exhibition, readers theatre skits and reading of selected works by the writers at a local venue, Maple View of Kenmare and the Kenmare Community Hospital. Visual and literary work will also be published in a book, with copies donated to public and school libraries and made available for local sale. All Kenmare Summer Arts Institute artists will receive a free copy of the summer's publication.

FEES: \$20 per child; additional \$5/workshop if child enrolls in more than one. Families with two or more children enrolled in the workshops will pay \$15 for each additional child's first workshop, plus \$5/workshop if child enrolls in more than one.

*Limited scholarship funds are available for families with special financial circumstances.
